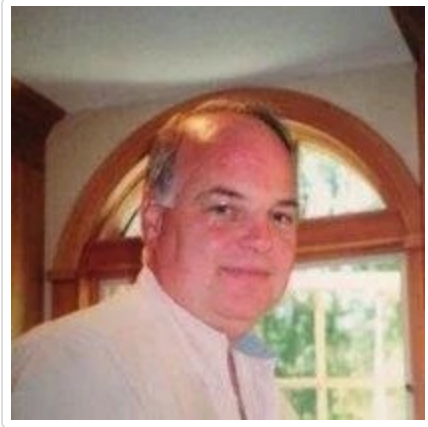




Jeffrey Russell Stafford

April 18, 1955 - February 25, 2013

Jeffrey Russell Stafford, 57, of West Hartford, passed peacefully at home on Monday, February 25, 2013, surrounded by his wife and children, after a twelve year battle with Multiple Myeloma. Jeff was born April 18, 1955 in Hartford and raised in Bloomfield and Groton Long Point. He graduated from the Kingswood School in 1973 and from Colby College in 1977 receiving Bachelors of Science in both Chemistry and Business. Jeff was an athlete at Kingswood playing football, riflery and lacrosse and went on to win three Varsity letters playing lacrosse at Colby. Jeff was the consummate salesman and took great pride in his work to promote the products of electronic manufacturers in Connecticut and throughout New England. He covered territories from New England to Florida before moving on to cover national sales. In September 1980, Jeff married Ellen McKone of West Hartford whom he leaves behind along with their four children Elizabeth Kurantowicz and her husband Greg of Fairfield, Julianne Stafford of Boston, Christopher Stafford of Norwalk and Courtney Stafford of New York City. He also leaves his dog Sophie whom he adored and a grandson to be born in April. Aside from being a loving husband and father, Jeff's greatest accomplishment was his battle against Multiple Myeloma. With the love, support, and care of his family, Dr. Reale and Dr. Dasanu along with his favorite nurses at Gothic Park, Jeff waged a battle that left most in awe. He became a fundraiser and advocate for the International Myeloma Foundation after his children started The Wamp Swim to raise funds to find a cure. Jeff's love of puns, the Red Sox, sailing,

jazz music, his International Scout, and a cold beer are just a few of the things he will be remembered for. Friends can pay their respects during calling hours on Friday, March 1 from 4-7 p.m. at the Molloy Funeral Home 906 Farmington Ave. West Hartford.
