Surrounded by family and friends, Ann Marie (Fitzgerald) Dombroskas, 60, beloved wife of Edward Dombroskas, passed peacefully from this life of complications from ALS on September 21, 2017. Born in Springfield, MA she was the daughter of Robert Fitzgerald and raised by her father, grandparents John and Mary Fitzgerald as well as aunt and uncle Maureen and Arthur Della Guistina. Recently moving to Berlin, Ann Marie was a long time resident of West Hartford. A graduate of Cathedral High School in Springfield and Saint Joseph College (BSRN) she also did graduate work at Southern Connecticut State University. In addition to her loving husband she is survived by her children whom she loved dearly, Edward (Ted) Dombroskas and his wife Mary of West Hartford, Robert Dombroskas and his fiancé Alle Perry of Natick, MA and Lynn Dombroskas of Old Saybrook and her dearest friend Michael Misiaszek of Groton. Ann Marie was devoted to God, family, friends, and her work as a nurse. She was a healer, friend, counselor, mentor, and fierce supporter. Simultaneously Ann Marie worked as a home care nurse. For many years she was a hospice nurse with the New Britain VNA and most recently worked with the Masters in Home Care agency in Wethersfield. No matter who she was with, or in what capacity, she was always nurturing and caring and would do or provide everything possible within her power.
