Alexander Harold Zimnoch, Sr. 60, beloved husband of Deborah Howe Zimnoch, of Ellington, died Sunday, October 9, 2005, at Brigham & Women's Hospital in Boston surrounded by his family. Born in Hartford, the son of the late Anthony and Alice Opalcz Zimnoch, he made his home in Ellington for the past 29 years. Alex served in the US Army during the Vietnam War and retired from the Connecticut Natural Gas Company after 25 years. Alex was a generous person who was the happiest when helping others. He was a longtime member of the BPOE #19, President of the Ellington Little League for more than a decade, member of the American Legion and founder of their baseball team, a volunteer for Toys for Tots and Make a Wish Foundation.
