Andrew Burr Campbell, of West Hartford, died at his home February 03, 2005. Mr. Campbell had a Bachelor's, Master's, and Juris Doctor degree and was a retired member of the Connecticut Bar. His business career was with the Travelers Insurance Company in Hartford. During this time he was, for 25 years, a member of the adjunct faculty of the Business School of the University of Hartford. During World War II, he was an infantry rifle company commander, in four campaigns in the Pacific, and received the Purple Heart and Bronze Star medals.

Mr. Campbell was a former member of the Greater Hartford Community Chest Budget Committee. He was also a former Chairman of the West Hartford Personnel Board, and a past President of both the Woodridge Association and the Hartford Squash Racquets Club. Mr. Campbell was a member of the Universalist Church of West Hartford. Mr. Campbell was dearly beloved and will be greatly missed by his family and friends. He is survived by his wife, Priscilla Campbell, and four sons, Andrew B. Campbell Jr. and Lawrence A. Campbell of West Hartford, Dr. Donald A. Campbell of Salt Lake City, Utah, and Dr. Russell B. Campbell of Cedar Falls, Iowa, and by two daughter-in-laws, Jo-Ann Campbell of West Hartford and Dr. Regula Burki of Salt Lake City, Utah, and six grandsons.
