January 22, 1923 - December 7, 2011

Our beloved mother, Angeline Manoogian , of West Hartford, died peacefully at her daughter's home in Fargo, ND December 7th after a courageous two-year battle against cancer. She was born on January 22, 1923, the daughter of the late Angelo and Lucy Augello Cantone in Hartford and moved to West Hartford in 1956. She graduated from Hartford High School, played basketball for St Anthony's Church CYO in the 1930's and 40's and worked for the Traveler's Insurance Co for 30 years. She was a charter member of the St Timothy's Church, board member of AARP, volunteer for Mt Sinai Hospital and the YMCA, and a tireless volunteer for West Hartford Senior Center activities. In 2001 Angie and her husband Ozzie received the Best Volunteer award for the West Hartford Senior Center. She loved dancing, painting, doing crafts, and gardening. She traveled extensively in the US and abroad. She was preceded in death by her cherished husband Arthur Ozzie Manoogian of 62 years. She leaves her children: daughter Sandra and her husband Tom Pearce of Fargo, North Dakota, and grandchildren David and Elizabeth; and son Arthur, Jr. and his wife Jean of San Clemente, CA and grandchild Brian--all of whom were very precious to her. She was also preceded in death by brothers Joseph I and II, Frank Cantone, and sister Ann Glofka.
