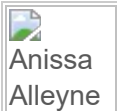

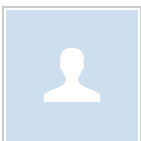

“ I worked very briefly with Anne when she was at IRIS and I was on the Board. My husband remembers my coming home to tell him about how wonderful I thought this new person was. Although I did not know her well, I looked forward to every meeting and conversation with her (even though the conversations were about fund-raising) because she was so much fun to be with, so funny, so kind, so fearless, so unlikely to become dejected, and because she brought out the best in all of us. She brought so much kindness and joy and humor and intelligence and grace to every interaction. She was the kind of woman I really looked up to and really wanted to be, even though we are the same age -- I really, really deeply admired her and often found myself wondering what she would do in a certain situation. And this is based on just a very brief window together -- just she was so open and honest and natural that it felt like I had known her for a much longer time. I suspect she made everyone feel that way. I cannot stop thinking about the enormity of this loss. I just refuse to believe it. My son started going to a new school today in a new country with many refugees, and the whole time all I could think about was how completely tirelessly and creatively Anne worked with and for refugees, and how much kindness and love she brought to the work -- how happy she'd be to see refugees thriving. Anne carried herself in every interaction with so much grace. So much grace. So much. She remains an inspiration to me in my work with refugees here and I will not forget the example that she set of how to live in this world.

I cannot convey enough how terribly, terribly, terribly sorry I am for the family. So very, very sorry. Heartbroken. I am so sorry.

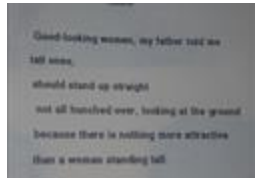
