



Anne Gallagher Isakson

Anne (Gallagher) Isakson, a longtime resident of West Hartford, Connecticut, passed away peacefully in her sleep on Tuesday, May 14, 2024. She was 90 years old.

Anne was born in White Park, Curraghboy, Co. Roscommon, Ireland to the late Patrick and Brigid Gallagher. She arrived in the United States via New York City in 1950, at age 16, and lived in the Boston area, graduating from Needham (Massachusetts) High School in 1953. Together with her loving husband, Donald H. Isakson, she lived in Wisconsin, California and finally settled in Connecticut for the past 63 years and raised four children in West Hartford as a homemaker. Anne was a committed volunteer at St. Mary's Home in West Hartford and at St. Francis Hospital in Hartford.

Donald, her husband of 59 years, pre-deceased Anne in 2017. She is survived by four children, Jeffery of District of Columbia, Daniel of Avon, Nancy of Old Saybrook and Elizabeth of New York City. Anne is also survived by 10 grandchildren: Michael, Kevin, Virginia, Kerry, Nicole, Clare, Jack, Erik, Peter and Nora.

She was the sister of the late Michael, Austin, Mary, Kieran and Patrick and is survived by siblings Bridie, Bernadette, Rita and Noel. Funeral services will be Tuesday, May 28, 2024, at 10 a.m. with a celebration of her Mass of Christian Burial at St. Thomas the Apostle Church, 872 Farmington Ave. in West

Hartford.
