



## Apolonija Vitkus

May 26, 1910 - September 1, 2009

Apolonija Antanaviciute Vitkus, 99, of West Hartford died peacefully at Sunrise Assisted Living of West Hartford on Tuesday, September 1, 2009. Widow of the late Joseph Vitkus, she was a woman of great faith. Born in her native Lithuania on May 26, 1910 she and her husband immigrated to the US in 1949 and has been part of the Holy Trinity Church family ever since. Apolonija was a charter member of the Lithuanian Woman's Federation Club for the entire period of its activities. Her works of art and paintings in straw have been displayed as part of Christmas exhibits both at the Wadsworth Athenaeum and at the Hartford Public Library. She taught the kindergarten class for Lithuanian students at the Holy Trinity Parish during the late 60's and early 70's. She was known for the colorful and varied Easter eggs that she decorated for decades. Apolonija will be greatly missed by her many friends. Funeral services will take place on Friday September 4, 2009 at 10:00 AM at the Holy Trinity Church, 53 Capitol Ave. in Hartford. All are invited to say their farewells at 9:30 AM prior to the service at the church. Burial will follow at the Gate of Heaven Cemetery, Putnam, CT.
