Arthur Gal, 91, beloved husband of Bertha Bloch Gal, of Avon and formerly West Hartford and Torrington, died Wednesday, February 29, 2012, at St. Francis Hospital. Born in Torrington, he made his home in West Hartford for 27 years, moving to Avon in 1991. Art graduated from Torrington High School in 1938, and formed an orchestra known as "Artie Gal's Radio & Recording Orchestra. They played at many weddings and ballrooms throughout New England. He was a foreman at the Torrington Co. for 25 years. In 1964 he started the Arthur Gal Real Estate Co. with offices in West Hartford, Simsbury, Avon and Torrington. He was a member of the Greater Hartford Board of Realtors serving as a director and was a 3rd Degree Knight of Columbus. Besides his wife of 65 years, he is survived by his two daughters: Joan Peck of West Hartford, Patricia Vautour and her husband Richard of West Hartford: his grandchildren; Scott Vautour and his wife Christina, Allison Peck Mandich and her husband Jimmy, Julie Peck, Amy Vautour Rheiner and her husband Justin; and his sister Clementine Pelchat of Torrington. He was predeceased by three sisters, Gen, Cecelia, and Anna.
