Barbara Heywood Field, daughter of Edith and Seth Heywood, was born in Gardner, MA on July 2, 1912. She graduated from Miss Hall's School in 1930 then studied a year in Paris at the Sorbonne and at Katherine Gibbs School in Boston. In 1934 she married the late Benjamin Rush Field and they moved to West Hartford in 1936 and made it her home for the remainder of her life.
