Charles G. Andrew, Sr. of West Hartford, CT, beloved husband of Ann Menary Andrew passed away peacefully on Saturday, November 28, 2009 at St. Mary Home. He was born and raised in Lakewood, OH the youngest son of the late Dudley and Anna Grebe Andrew. He was a proud graduate of St. Ignatius Jesuit High School, Cleveland, OH. Charlie received his BS from the University of Pennsylvania and his MBA from The Wharton School of Business. Upon graduation, he began his professional career at Peat, Marwick, Mitchell one of the Big 8 CPA firms as a management consultant. While working in New York City he met his future wife, Ann, and they were married in 1961. In 1964 he accepted a position as Manufacturing Manager for Superior Electric and moved to West Hartford, CT. In 1976, he became a Professor of Management within The Barney School of Business at the University of Hartford. Charlie also led the Production Management segment of the University's Executive MBA Program. In 1980 he fulfilled his lifelong dream of establishing his own consulting firm. It grew into a successful international business with clients throughout the US, Europe and Asia. Charlie went on to author over 50 papers and articles for professional journals and was recognized as an authority on Japanese and Western World management practices and implementation strategies. Charlie and Ann spent many happy years raising their four children in West Hartford. During those years, Charlie was a devoted parishioner of The Church of St. Timothy. He

was a believer in positive thinking and that there was nothing you could not accomplish. Charlie was a caring father to each of his children providing guidance and encouragement taking great pride in each of their achievements. He and Ann traveled the world creating many lasting memories. Charlie had a passion for jogging and walking particularly at Reservoir 6 and treasured the friendships he made there.
