Clifford "Chris" Quentin Christensen, 87, of Farmington, formerly of West Hartford, and beloved husband of 63 years to Catharine Cronin Christensen, died Thursday, November 2, 2006 with his family close by. He was born in Monmouth, IL, the son of the late Fred and Cona Waymack Christensen. He graduated from Monmouth College and enlisted in the Army Field Artillery. He served as Battery Commander of the 694th Field Artillery in the Pacific Theater during World War II. Chris joined Aetna Casualty and Surety Co. in 1946 as a surety bond representative. He went on to become Bond Department manager in Hartford for more than ten years, leaving Aetna in 1970 to join Charles H. McDonough agency as bond manager. In 1982, he assumed the position of vice-president, bonds, at Alexander & Alexander of CT. Chris joined RC Knox & Co. in 1990 as senior bond consultant, responsible for providing contract surety advice for major contractor accounts. Chris had been active with the National Association of Surety Bond Producers, serving as the National Chairman of the Governmental Affairs Committee, the Regional Vice-President, and Board member. He served on the Board of the Connecticut Road Builders Association. Besides his wife, Catharine, he is survived by two sons, Mark Christensen and his wife, Kathleen of Bolton and Robert Christensen and his wife, Sara of Thetford Center, VT and a grandchild, Ashley Christensen of Bolton.
