Christopher Adam Stewart, 34, of Delray Beach, FL, passed away unexpectedly on Monday, February 12th, 2018. Born in New Britain on December 10th, 1983, Chris grew up in Rocky Hill until moving to Newington in 2007, and then to Delray Beach in 2015. He graduated from Rocky Hill High School in 2002 where he loved science, art, creative writing, played varsity soccer, and was a member of the National Honor Society. Intelligent, inquisitive, and hard-working, Chris received Bachelor's Degrees in both Neuroscience from Trinity College and Diagnostic Imaging from Quinnipiac University. He then studied Molecular Cell Biology as a graduate student, and always hoped his research in this field would benefit others. Chris had a loving heart, a generous spirit, and was a person of integrity and kindness. He loved his family, friends, animals, nature, science, photography, and a good game of basketball. His smile, sense of humor, and infectious laugh could light up a room. He had a way of bringing out the best in people and was truly loved by all whose lives he touched. Along with his beloved parents, Jean (Johnson) Stewart and Arthur Stewart, both of Newington, he leaves behind his loving sister Jennifer (Stewart) Fanning, her husband Michael Fanning, and their children, Maddie and Mason Fanning, of West Hartford.
