Mr. Christopher John White, 61, of West Hartford, CT passed away surrounded by love on April 1, 2022 from injuries sustained in a motorcycle accident on March 18, 2022.

Christopher was born on November 28, 1960 in New York, NY. He was predeceased by his parents Victoria Ramos and Christopher James White. He was also predeceased by his beloved Stepfather John O'Leary and both of his brothers Paul White and John O'Leary Jr. He is survived by his wife, Leslie White, their two children, Anthony White(33), Nicole White(29), and his grandchildren Autumn(5), Jaxon(2), and Aurora(1). Chris always had a special place in his heart for all six of his nieces and nephews. Chris grew up in New York City and became an EMT prior to joining the Navy in 1979. He was extremely proud of his Military service. Soon after he met the love of his life, Leslie, while living in Boston where he was The Program Director of the Boy's Club in Cambridge, Mass. They moved to CT to start their family. Most of his career was spent managing properties. Chris dedicated much of his time to the community through many different avenues such as Boy/Eagle Scouts, Youth Arts Programs, local soup kitchens,

substance abuse programs, and local senior centers. He truly enjoyed using his unique personality and talents to spread joy and lift those around him. Chris was a member of the local APA Billiards League for many years, a bonding experience he loved with his son. This was a passion that his father passed to him, and he successfully passed to his son.

As a professional magician, Chris was accepted into the National Society of Magicians. He enjoyed meeting up with the “Old timers” for their monthly meetings where they would share their behind-the-scenes secrets. As an accomplished musician Chris played several instruments but was mind blowing when he sat behind his drum set. Chris and his wife Leslie would spend countless hours jamming through the night in the “Drumgeon” studio that he created as their escape. Chris was so excited to recently start taking base lessons at LaSalle so he could jam with “The Guys.”

Chris "Superman" White was truly loved by all that knew him. A lasting impression that made a difference in many lives.
