



Clinton Charles Hanks

October 22, 1915 - December 17, 2008

Clinton C. Hanks, 93, died on December 17, 2008 at his home in Coventry where he lived briefly after moving from his home in West Hartford in June, 2008. He was predeceased by his wife Marion Tolley Hanks and his brothers Stedman and Russell, both formerly of Storrs, CT. He is survived by his wife June Woolaver, his son Curtis and his wife Ruth of Coventry. He is also survived by his grandsons, Glen Hanks Laura of Coral Springs, FL, and Alan Hanks Meghan of Coventry, CT. He has two great grandchildren, Brianna and Joshua Hanks, both of Coral Springs, FL. He was born on Hanks Hill in Storrs, CT where he lived until his marriage to Marion in 1939. He resided in West Hartford from then until June 2008. He worked at Smith-Worthington Saddlery for 65 years, beginning as an office boy during the Depression, and eventually owning the historic company. He was a scoutmaster for troop 44 for many years, and was a member of the United Methodist Church of west Hartford.
