David Horowitz of West Hartford, CT, peacefully passed away on January 23, 2024, surrounded by his loving family, after a long but very brave battle with brain cancer.

Born on November 14, 1949, he was the beloved son of Jack and Vera (Stojak) Horowitz. Raised in West Hartford, he graduated from Uconn as well as receiving his Masters in taxation at UHart. He co-founded the firm "Harvey and Horowitz" in 1987 shortly after making partner at Touche Ross.

He was a dedicated patriot, serving in the US Air Force Reserves for 6 years and a proud member of the American Legion Post 96 for an impressive 51 years, where he continued to serve and support fellow veterans.
