David B. Kennedy, 70, of Bloomfield CT passed away on Good Friday, April 10th, peacefully at home after a courageous battle with cancer. Dave graduated from Holyoke Catholic High School and St. Anselm's College and went on to marry the love of his life, Virginia (Ginny) Kennedy on June 24, 1978. He is survived by his wife, Ginny of Bloomfield, his daughter, Aly Mills and her husband, David Mills of Atlanta, GA; his son, Chris Kennedy and his wife, Kari Kennedy of Cuming, GA as well as his beloved grandchildren, Ryan Kennedy, Kennedy (Birdie) Mills and Murray Mills. Dave started his career at Scott Graphics in South Hadley, MA and then moved on to a career in medical sales working for such companies as Squibb, Pfizer, and Hewlett Packard.
