Born in Brooklyn, NY, to Italian immigrants Placida and Frank Bernardo, Dominick was the oldest of four siblings. He joined the U.S. Navy at 17 and served in World War II, where he participated in D-Day at Juno Beach. He also served in the Korean War. After Dominick was honorably discharged from the Navy, he joined the Bell Telephone Company, working his way up the leadership ranks, eventually becoming a manager for Verizon. After retiring, Dominick split his time between Rocky Hill, CT and Treasure Island, FL. In his nearly 103 years, Dominick enjoyed watching baseball (the NY Mets and later the Tampa Bay Rays), playing pool and eating his favorite Italian food. He was predeceased by his wife Louise Aravalle Bernardo, and his brothers Vincent and Joseph Bernardo, and his sister Delores Agner. He is survived by his daughter Donna Finn of Cutchogue, NY, and granddaughters Elizabeth Lange of Carlsbad, CA, Meghann Sepulveda of Chandler, AZ, and Keara Deller of Phoenix, AZ, along with his eight great-grandchildren.
