



## Donald D. Pascal

April 18, 1918 - October 31, 2013

Donald D. Pascal, husband of Lois D. Pascal, passed away at Duncaster Retirement Community on October 31, 2013. He was born in Newark, NJ in 1918, the son of Stanton M. Pascal and Florence (Carroll) Pascal. He grew up in Maplewood, NJ and graduated from Blair Academy in Blairstown, NJ. Don attended Yale University and graduated from their School of Engineering in 1940. Following graduation he moved to Hartford, CT, where he was employed by Pratt & Whitney Aircraft for 40 years, actively engaged in the development of many of Pratt's commercial and military aircraft engines. In 1958 he was transferred to P&WA's Florida Research and Development Center as Assistant Chief Engineer. Other highlights of his career included positions as Chief Engineer, Production Engines and Manager of Engineering Technology. After retiring from his last position as Vice President, Group Product Integrity in 1980, Don pursued his love for designing and building antique reproduction furniture. Golf, tennis, hiking and birding were among his favorite activities. He was a member of The Old Guard of West Hartford, the 1892 Club and the Stonington Country Club.
