Doris Stavola Uricchio, of West Hartford, passed away peacefully on May 10, 2006. She was the wife of the late Ralph Uricchio. Born in Hartford, to the late Rose and John Stavola she resided for the past 64 years in West Hartford. She was in the 1930 graduating class at Bulkeley High School, the first class to spend all four years at the school which opened in 1926. A talented creative writer, she had her work published in a national magazine, Modern Priscilla, in 1929. She was also a member of the National Honor Society. One of Hartford's first successful women business owners, she and her sister, Rose Zazzaro received a \$500 loan from the Hartford National Bank, an unheard of accomplishment for women in the thirties, enabling them to open The Knitter's Shop in the American Industrial Building in downtown Hartford in 1936. Mrs. Uricchio is survived by her brother, Felix Stavola, of Farmington, three daughters, Ann Plompen and her husband, Joseph, of Farmington, Jane Biral and Donna Lemieux and her husband Alcide, Jr. of West Hartford; four grandchildren, Theresa Maselli and her husband Anthony of Burlington, Tammy Heath and her husband Ryan of Florida, Alcide Lemieux III and his wife Kathy, and Michael Biral all of West Hartford; six great-grandchildren whom she adored; Anthony, Rachel, Angelina and Sophia Maselli, Benjamin and Alcide Lemieux IV. She was predeceased by her sisters Rose Zazzaro, Mary Stefano, and her brother Francis Stavola.
