Edith Ann Thompson, 84, of Bloomfield, beloved wife of 30 years of Rob Thompson, Edie as she was known passed away peacefully, surrounded by family members on Saturday, December 6, 2025 following a sudden cerebrovascular accident. She had been under the wonderful care of Hospice at John Dempsey Hospital in Farmington since the Wednesday before. Edie was born in Winthrop, MA to Richard Forestall Sewall and Margaret Tully Hollywood Sewall. She was raised in Cape Elizabeth, ME and after High School would graduate from Colby College in Waterville, ME.
