



Edward Blaschinski

November 24, 1918 - October 25, 2009

Edward Blaschinski, CPA, 90, the husband of Mildred Pietrycha, died Sunday Oct. 25, 2009 in West Hartford where he had made his home for most of his adult life. Born in Hartford, the son of the late John and Eva Kolakowski Blaschinski, he was a graduate of Hartford Public High School, Bay Path College, and the Hartford Institute of Accounting. He owned and operated an independent accounting firm in Hartford for over 64 years. Ed was a US Army Air Corps Veteran of WW II, serving in the European Theater of Operations with the IX Engineer Command, the 850th Engine Battalion. He was active in Little League and Alumni League Baseball in West Hartford, devoting many hours to coaching various teams. He served on numerous fund raising and civic boards to benefit his community and St. Cyril and St. Methodius Church and FAMA. Ed was instrumental in organizing the erection of the Casimir Pulaski Monument in Hartford. He also served as an accountant for the Polish National Home. He is survived by his wife Mildred and his two children; daughter Nancy Blaschinski, son and daughter-in-law Dennis and Ellen Blaschinski, grandsons Edward, Charles and Theodore all of West Hartford. He also leaves his sister-in-law Barbara Blaschinski, two nieces, Sharon Allen and Noran Baranello, and his nephew James Blaschinski. He was predeceased by his brother Vincent. The funeral will be Wednesday Oct. 28, beginning with a procession at 9:30 a.m. from the Molloy Funeral Home 906 Farmington Ave. West Hartford. The celebration of his Mass of Christian Burial will follow at 10:00 a.m. in St. Thomas the Apostle Church, West
