Edward N. Mullarkey, 97, husband of the late Claire Chapman Mullarkey, died Tuesday October 6, 2009 at Hartford Hospital. Born in Hartford, the son of the late Patrick and Margaret Durkin Mullarkey, he had made his home in Hartford most of his life. He was a graduate of Hartford Public High School 1930, and Trinity College 1934, where he was a member of the track team. He had been active for many years in Our Lady of Sorrows Parish.
