Edwin A. Gittleman, 81, the husband of Marilyn Wolf Gittleman, died Sunday, January 7, 2007 at St. Francis Hospital in Hartford. Born in New York City, NY, the son of the late Morton and Gertrude Kaplan Gittleman, he had made his home in Bloomfield the past 38 years. A U.S. Army veteran of World War II, he was a graduate of Long Island University and earned his MBA from City College of New York. He worked in sales promotion and was the former advertising director for the Sage Allen Co in Hartford for a number of years. Active in Democratic town politics in Bloomfield, Mr. Gittleman was a member of the Bloomfield Board of Tax Review and the Democratic Town Committee. He was a former member of the Hartford Area Cable Television Advisory Council for 35 years, the Bloomfield Library Board, the Bloomfield representative to the Tobacco Valley Tourism Board, the Wintonbury Historical Society, and the Bloomfield Volunteer Ambulance of which he was a founding member. He was a race car enthusiast. Besides his wife Marilyn, to whom he had been married the past 59 years, he is survived by his daughter, Elyse Gittleman of West Hartford; his brother, Maurice Gittleman in New Jersey; his former sister-in-law and close friend, Adele Gittleman; his niece and nephew and their families.
