Eleanor ?Bobbie? Galt Stafford, of Seabury in Bloomfield and Groton Long Point, died Sunday, April 25, 2004 at Hartford Hospital after a brief illness. She was the wife of 44 years of the late Thomas R. Stafford. She was born May 22, 1928 to Eleanor Williams and Paul T. Galt in Hartford. A 1946 graduate of The Oxford School WH and of Colby Junior College NH, Bobbie lived in Simsbury and Suffield before moving to Bloomfield in 1957 with her young family. She never left the town. Bobbie was involved in volunteer activities, including the Junior League and Lupus research at the UCONN Medical Center. She enjoyed many years employment at Park Avenue Pharmacy in Bloomfield. Bobbie was a former communicant of Old St. Andrews Church. She was a lifelong member of the Groton Long Point Yacht Club and the Mystic Seaport. She is survived by three daughters and a son: Louise Stafford of Farmington, Lee Stafford and her companion, Michael Rafferty, of Noank, Jeffrey Stafford and his wife Ellen McKone-Stafford of West Hartford, and Kendall Stafford of New London. Bobbie also leaves seven grandchildren; Nicholas, Maryn, and Patrick Mikula, and Elizabeth, Julianne, Christopher and Courtney Stafford. She leaves her sister, Louise G. Pease of West Hartford, and is also survived by her longtime companion Samuel ?Pres? Clement of Seabury in Bloomfield.
