They enjoyed close friendships with neighbors and had the pleasure of living next to Paul's brother and his family. Five years later, in accordance with Betty's plan, their first son, David Paul was born. She left her job as a legal secretary to stay home with David and three years later Kevin was born.

Betty was a devoted mother and wife. Her home was where neighborhood children would stop in and be assured a cookie and lemonade. Nieces, nephews and friends often sought Betty's wise counsel. She was a good listener, diplomatic and sage. She was always happy to enjoy a cup of coffee and chat and she generously shared recipes and taught several nieces to bake and cook.
