



## Ellen P. Carmichael

December 21, 1961 - June 6, 2011

Ellen Petkaitis Carmichael, 49, beloved wife of Gordon Carmichael of West Hartford, died Monday, June 6, 2011, from injuries sustained in an automobile accident. Born in Manchester, the daughter of Romualda Babaliauskas Petkaitis of West Hartford and the late Albin Petkaitis, she made her home in West Hartford for the past 20 years. Ellen graduated from Fairfield University with a Bachelors degree in Biology and received her PhD from the UConn Health Center in Molecular Biology and Biochemistry. Ellen was an avid sportsman who enjoyed golf, basketball and softball. In recent years her favorite pastime was camping and fishing and she was a friend of Bill W. She most recently established a Facebook page, "Our Moms' Lithuanian Recipes", which has brought people together from the Lithuanian community to share recipes of favorite dishes. She was very proud of how popular this page had become. Besides her husband and mother, she is survived by her two sons, Gregory and Jeffrey Carmichael of West Hartford; her brother Anthony Petkaitis of FL; two sisters, Rita Petkaitis of MA and Irene Cooper of VA; and a special friend Vytautas Zdanys. Celebration of her life will be held on Saturday, June 11 at 3:00 p.m. at the Molloy Funeral Home, 906 Farmington Ave., West Hartford. Donations in her memory may be made to the Humane Society.

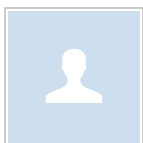
