Mr. Norman served with dignity in the US Army during World War II as a Staff Sergeant Tech 4 Grade, and was discharged honorably, and was awarded both the Croix De Guerre and Knight Commander of the Sovereign Military Order of the Temple of Jerusalem Knights Templar. He was an avid watercolor artist whose paintings appeared in many juried shows. Besides his fiancé, Geraldine Lescard Williams, he is survived by his two children and their spouses, Janice and Douglas Larson of West Hartford, Robert E. and Patricia Norman of Oak Hill, VA; four grandchildren, Christopher and Jonathan Larson, Andrew and Katherine Norman. 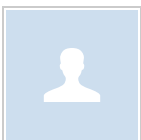

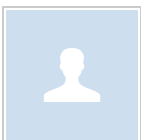
