Aragón, Francisco (80) of Manchester passed away peacefully on March 25, 2016, surrounded by his loving family and friends at Saint Francis Hospital. A native of Mollepata, Cusco, Peru, He was the son of the late Demetrio Aragón and Maria Orellana; a caring husband to Maria M. Santa-Cruz and preceded in death by his daughter Ana Maria Aragón Santa-Cruz (1979). He had two siblings Mercedes and Cornelio. Francisco immigrated to the United States in 1971, worked for Emhart Corporation for 25 years. He established a foundation on his daughter's name (1980-2015) to help the poor children in Peru. He was a very active member of Our Lady of Sorrows Church. He worked year around in support of the annual procession of the Lord of Miracles of Perú in Hartford and served as a President and Adviser for many terms for HESMIPERU (1972-2013). He was the founder of OHCAPERUSA an organization that united all the Peruvian Catholic Brotherhoods in USA and Canada (27 years). He was member of the "Counseling Board" of the Peruvian Consulate in Connecticut and Rhode Island. He is survived by nieces, nephews, relatives and friends. Francisco will be fondly remembered for his love of family, his strong Catholic faith, and his support for others less fortunate. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Saturday, April 2 at Our Lady of Sorrows Church, 79 New Park Avenue, Hartford at 10:00 AM. Interment will follow in Fairview Cemetery in West Hartford.
