McGloin, Francis 79 of West Hartford, Connecticut passed away peacefully on Tuesday, September 20, 2011. Frank was born in Ballyshannon, Co. Donegal, Ireland on March 29, 1932 the son of Winifred McPhelim and John James McGloin.

He spent several years working at home in Ballyshannon and abroad in England before emigrating to the United States in October of 1963. Frank began working with his brothers in Connecticut as an Ironworker and was a proud member of Ironworkers Local 15.
