Frank Skwar, of Farmington, CT, late of Clearwater, FL., and formerly from Bloomfield, N.J., died Thursday morning after a brief illness at the Brittany Farms Health Center in New Britain, CT. He was 91. Mr. Skwar grew up in Kearny, N.J., the son of Frank and Margaret Skwar. He was graduated from Kearny H.S. and worked as an usher and for the WPA program in Washington State before serving in the US Army in World War II. Mr. Skwar married Irene Jacunski of Bloomfield in 1947 and worked as a machinist for 27 years for Weston Corporation of Newark, N.J. His wife, Irene, died in 1981. He later married Edna Croto Graham and retired to Clearwater in 1983. An avid golfer and bowler, Frank joined an elite club when he bowled a perfect game -- 300 - at the age of 75. He is survived by his son, Don Skwar, of Farmington, his three grandchildren; Krystal, Julia, and Michael, and his sister Bertha. He was predeceased by his son Tom.
