Freddy Burgos, 32, of West Hartford, died on April 1, 2007. Born in New York, the son of Jose Freddy Burgos of Rocky Hill, and Antonia Burgos of Simsbury. Freddy was a 1992 graduate of Bulkeley High School and later the University of Hartford. In 2003 Freddy graduate from the Hartford Police academy and joined the City of Hartford Police Department. He truly loved his job with the City of Hartford. Freddy also loved animals, and exercising, especially mountain biking. In addition to his parents he is survived by his grandmother Mercedes Burgos, of Hartford; 2 brothers, Anthony of Washington, D.C., and Ruben of Simsbury; a sister Cindy and her husband Mario Perez of Simsbury; a niece Madison Burgos; as well as a girlfriend Jennifer Zanardi of West Hartford. Funeral services will be Tuesday, with the celebration of a Mass of Christian Burial at 10:00 a.m. in St. Peter Claver Church, 47 Pleasant St. West Hartford. 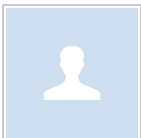
