Frederick Forbes Hauptman, 79, of West Hartford and Madison, died Saturday Dec. 31, 2005 at Hartford hospital. He is the husband of Doris Anne Adams Hauptman to whom he had been married for 53 years. Forbes was born in Los Angeles, CA, son of the late George D. and Harriet Forbes Hauptman, and was a long time resident of West Hartford. He was well known for his generosity to friends and strangers. Mr. Hauptman and his wife summered in Madison. An independent contractor, he worked for many years at the Connecticut Building at the Big E, and served as a Connecticut Trustee for the Big E. He was a U.S. Army veteran of WW II, and retired from the armed forces after 25 years of service. He was the first Sgt. Major of the U. S. Army serving in a MASH Unit, traveling the country in a hospital train. He was a Governor of the Madison Beach club, a founder of the Key Lock and Lantern, and a member of many railroad associations. Besides his wife, he is survived by his sons and daughters-in-law; Frederick Forbes Hauptman, Jr. and his wife Katie Jennings of Bainbridge Island, Washington, Russell Carey Hauptman and his wife Charlene of Wilmington, NC, and four grandsons, Walker, Benjamin, Gregory and Jason.
