Genevieve Urban, 87, passed away peacefully on May 29, 2024 during a short stay at Autumn Lake Rehab, in West Hartford, CT. She was born in Poland on July 22, 1936 to Mary Gaska Urban and John Urban. She was sent to Siberia during World War II with her mother, aunts, grandparents, and infant brother, and her grandparents and brother did not survive the harsh conditions. After being released, she lived in Africa as a refugee until 1947 when she joyfully arrived in Hartford, CT, where she lived for the rest of her life. She attended Hartford Public High School and took great pride in her employment at Veeder-Root, where she worked as a part's inspector. She was a communicant of SS Cyril and Methodius for many years and was a member of The Holy Rosary Society, Ladies Guild and The Golden Seniors. She was the family beauty, known for her impeccable style and flair for fashion. She was an indomitable force who charged the atmosphere of every room she walked into. But most of all, she was a devoted daughter, who steadfastly cared for and protected her mother Mary until the day of her death in 2004. She was predeceased by her mother and father, step-father Benjamin Wycko, and infant brother, Chester. She leaves behind her dear friend of over 50 years, Aleksander Trusewicz, her loving cousins Jean Tamborello, Christina Taylor, Regina Alexander, and Teresa Svendsgaard, and their families.
