George Alfred Schulz, 89, of Hartford and the Unionville section of Farmington, died Thursday July 8, 2004 at Hartford Hospital. Born in Unionville, the son of the late George A. and Maria Pallada Schulz, Sr., he had made his home in this area for all his life.
