Gisele Gagnon Miller of Biltmore Park, Bloomfield, died of cancer on Thursday, April 16, at Hartford Hospital. Mrs. Miller is survived by her beloved husband Nick, two sons and daughters-in-law Paul and Antonia Miller of Granby, Marc and Patti Miller of Glens Falls, NY, granddaughter Morgan Miller of Glens Falls, NY, grandson Jason Decoteau of Barre, VT and her brother Lt. Col. (Ret) Andre Gagnon of Montreal. Gisele was born in Montreal, attended McGill University, coming to New York in 1961 for a position with the Agent General of the Province of Quebec. She moved to West Hartford when she married in 1963. She enjoyed speaking French, her native language, and belonged to the Alliance Francaise, Le Petite Circle, and other French speaking groups. She served as President of the Alliance Francaise for seven years, during which time she founded the Alliance Francaise French Language School. She was an active docent at the Wadsworth Atheneum for over 30 years, served as President of the Docent's Council and as a museum Elector. She was a great hostess and loved to give dinner parties for friends. She raised 2 active sons, enjoying many active outdoor activities – biking, skiing, ice skating, but tennis was her most favorite sport. She was an avid camera photographer. The Millers lived in West Hartford, Simsbury, Bloomfield area for over 50 years, and for 15 years maintained a mountain retreat in Stowe, Vermont.
