Harold R. Fenton, 99, of Bloomfield, passed away on Saturday February 23, 2019. Born in Springfield, Massachusetts, he was the son of the late Harold and Mabel (Seery) Fenton. The devoted husband of the late Julia Fenton, together they lovingly raised 5 children. Harold was a 1936 graduate of Simsbury High School. A 75 year resident of Bloomfield, he was a local building contractor and built many homes in and around Bloomfield as well as the original Bloomfield Town Center, which included retail stores and the Post Office. He served on the Town Building Committee for the Library and was the Chairman of the Town Hall Building Committee. He also served as President of the Connecticut Chapter of the National Association of Home Builders. He was an active member of Sacred Heart Parish and served the Church and School on the Parish Council, Finance Committee and School Board. He lived by a set of values that he developed at a very young age including honesty, integrity and consideration of others above himself. With a smile and his signature greeting of “hi-ho”, his welcoming presence was appreciated by all those who crossed his path. Above all, he valued his relationship with family and friends and supported them selflessly throughout his life.
