Herbert L. Granstein of West Hartford, died Friday April 14, 2006 at his home. He was the son of Charles I and Carrie Gross Granstein and was born in Brockton, MA Jan. 25, 1916. He graduated Chicopee High school in 1933, from the College of William and Mary in 1937 and received a M.L.S. degree from Southern Connecticut State University in 1969. Mr. Granstein retired from Northwestern Connecticut Community College as an Associate Professor in 1979. Mr. Granstein was a founder and chairman of the Association of Jewish Cemeteries of Greater Hartford, a unit of the Hartford Jewish Federation for its first 12 years. He was also the founder and first president of the N.C. Foundation in Winsted, CT for six years. Mr. Granstein was a past chancellor of John Hay Lodge #61, Knights of Pythias, a past president of the Bloomfield-Capitol City Kiwanis Club, and a member of many other fraternal orders. Mr. Granstein leaves two sons, Mark H. Granstein and Charles P. Granstein both of West Hartford, his granddaughter Jennifer Amy Granstein of Lincoln, RI. He also leaves a brother Dr. Eugene G. Howard of Boca Raton, FL, several nieces and nephews, and was predeceased by his sister Mrs. Harold Fanchon Ratner.
