Inge Goetz, 87, wife of Helmut Goetz, of West Hartford, died September 3, 2024. She was born in Stettin, Germany, on November 29, 1936 to Bruno Polzin and Erika Grueger. The Russian Army moved in to Germany at the end of World War II and occupied the Pommern area of Germany which is now part of Poland. The she and her mother were forced to flee with just their clothes to West Germany into resettlement camps. After making their way to Berlin she would apprentice as a secretary at Simence in Berlin before her Onkel sponsored her to move to the United States. In the US she initially settled in New York and worked on Wall St. Inge and her mom took a vacation to Puerto Rico where she met Helmut while he was working for Hilton Hotel Corporation, they began to date and would eventually marry in 1967 in Berlin. In 1974 the moved to Connecticut and she and Helmut would open the Edelweiss Restaurant in West Hartford Center until their retirement in 1998. Funeral services will be at a later date.
