Dr. James F. McAndrews, 85, of Bloomfield and formerly West Hartford, son of Margaret nee Edwards and Walter McAndrews, died Friday, November 24, 2006 at Hartford Hospital. He was born in Norwood, MA. and grew up in the southend of Hartford. Jim graduated from Loomis School in Windsor and Trinity College in Hartford. He graduated from Columbia Medical School in 1946 and then interned at Hartford Hospital in 1946-47. He then went to New York's Columbia Presbyterian Hospital for a residency in urology. He returned to Hartford Hospital where he remained for the rest of his career except for a tour of duty at the 43rd MASH in 1953, during the Korean War. He is survived by his wife, Kathleen Curry McAndrews and was predeceased by his wife, Grace Randall McAndrews.
