



## Joan Frances Luby

March 30, 1919 - May 12, 2009

Joan Frances Luby died in West Hartford on Tuesday, May 12, 2009 after a short illness. She is the daughter of the late Thomas J. Luby, MD and Frances Mead Luby. She was predeceased by her sister Marcella L. Mansfield and brothers Thomas J. Luby, Jr. DDS and Meade J. Luby, MD. A brother, William J. Luby of West Hartford, and twelve nieces and nephews survive. Joan was a graduate of The College of St. Elizabeth; she was also one of the first female graduates at the Maxwell School of Syracuse University and the Law School of the University of Connecticut. For many years Joan worked nationally in the field of employee productivity as a consultant for H.B. Maynard, a pioneering industrial engineering and productivity management firm. Joan was active in the American Management Association for whom she wrote, lectured, and conducted seminars. At Travelers, she was one of the first board-appointed female corporate officers. Joan practiced law with a focus in taxation and also worked for the State of Connecticut and United Technologies. In addition to spending time at her Cape Cod home, Joan enjoyed extensive travel in Europe and the United States. Among her many interests were state and local politics, where she was active in a number of campaigns. Joan was fiercely independent, very accomplished and always willing to help others.
