John H. Woodruff, M.D., 93, formerly of West Hartford, died June 12 at Duncaster in Bloomfield. He was born April 8, 1918 in Passaic, NJ to John and Anna Woodruff. He attended Columbia University and Columbia P&S and then served in the Navy Medical Corps in WW II as a lieutenant. Dr. Woodruff was a retired radiologist with Jefferson Radiology Group and a medical consultant to many Hartford-area insurance companies. As a lifelong Yankees fan, his favorite pastime was watching their games. He also loved spending time in the summer at Moosehead Lake in Maine. Dr. Woodruff was the proud and loving father of Susan Hanzelko David, Linda Woodruff, Anne Stout Mark, and John Diane, and the beloved grandfather of Coryell, Tyler, and Eleanor Stout. For 61 years, he was the devoted husband of Lois Woodruff, who died in 2008.
