Joseph E. McCabe, 72, formerly of West Hartford, died Friday October 20, 2023 at St. Patrick's Manor in Framingham MA. Born in Middletown, he was the son of the late H. John McCabe and Grace (Dunn) McCabe. Joe was a 1969 graduate of Xavier High School in Middletown and a 1973 graduate of Trinity College. At Trinity, he was the President of Alpha Chi Rho. Joe was a star athlete, a football and baseball player for both Xavier and Trinity, and a star outfielder for the Middletown American Legion baseball team. He was the first Xavier team captain to be named captain of his college team. In 2014, Joe was inducted into the Middletown Sports Hall of Fame. He went on to earn his MBA at Boston College and had a long career as a CFA and investment analyst, most recently at UBS. Joe was very active in his church, remembered every sporting event his children ever played in, and took great pride in his family. Joe was preceded in death by his loving wife Doreen (Dooley) McCabe. He is survived by his daughters Megan McCabe Welch and her husband Matthew of Natick, MA, Katelyn McCabe Willis and her husband Nicholas of San Diego, CA, and son Brendan McCabe of Hartford, CT, grandchildren Christopher and Emma Welch and Addison and Callahan Willis, sisters Joyce (McCabe) O'Rourke, Janet (McCabe) Cahill, and brother Jack McCabe. Funeral services will be Friday, with a Mass of Christian Burial at 10 am at St. Thomas the Apostle Church, 872 Farmington Ave. W. Hartford. Burial will follow in Fairview Cemetery.
