Ju Chao Liu, 65, of Farmington died Monday May 1, 2006. He was the beloved husband of Tsing Pie Liu. Born in Changhua, Taiwan, he was former resident of Newington and West Hartford prior to moving to Farmington. Besides his wife, he is survived by two daughters, Teh-yi and Tsing-yi, son-in-law, Rafael Araque and a granddaughter, Sophie Araque-Liu. J.C. is known for his pioneering work in the synthesis of the chemical that causes luminescence that had previously only been found in nature, as part of his Ph.D. research in Organic Chemistry. He was the first named to a salaried position requiring a Ph.D. degree in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico. He expanded his research work with Loctite / Henkel in the field of adhesives and solvents where he held several patents. Until his initial stroke, he was an active member of the Taiwanese Organization of Connecticut. He will be missed by friends and family.
