Julia Theresa Freeman Fanelli passed away on April 24, 2010, in the presence of her loving daughter, attended by the devoted nursing staff of Jefferson House in Newington. She was ninety four.

Julia was married to Michael in 1946, and moved to West Hartford where they resided for fifty three years. She was the family historian who remembered every name and all the details of every relationship.
