Born in New Britain, son of the late Henry and Alice Eliason, he graduated from Tri-State University in Angola, IN and went to work as a manufacturing engineer at Jacobs Manufacturing. He formed his own companies, RDS Tool and the JC Barrett Company and then went to work for New Britain Plastics Machine Company. At the age of 64 he went back to work for the City of Hartford Health Department as a Lead Sanitarian and worked there 11 years retiring at the end of 2004. Ken was a long time member of Wampanoag Country club, Westbrook Elks Club, and the Cow Hill Yacht Club. He especially loved summers boating and spending weekend aboard the "Barhopper" in Old Saybrook and Block Island. Winters were spent in Naples and Vero Beach, FL.
