Lance Richard Hultgren, 64, died June 15, 2012 at his home in West Hartford, CT. Lance was the son of the late Harry Waldemar Hultgren, Jr. and Jean Hamilton Hultgren and was born and raised in West Hartford. He was a graduate of William H. Hall high school and briefly attended college before joining the United States Army. He served 1968-1969 as a sergeant in the Vietnam War, stationed in South Korea. After returning to the states he married Katharine Bockus of Litchfield, CT and started his decades long career in the insurance industry while earning his Bachelor of Arts (1974) and Master of Business Administration (1985) from the University of Connecticut. He is survived by two children, Ingrid Hultgren Camill and her husband Todd of Los Angeles, CA, and Lance Blake Hultgren of Windsor, CT; one grandchild, Dominic Camill and his former wife Katharine Van Waters. He is also survived by his sister, Diane E. Bennett of West Hartford, CT, his niece, Laura Bennett DeGennaro and her family of Cheshire, CT and nephews, Erik and Robert Hultgren of Erie, PA. He was predeceased by his brother, Philip Hultgren in March of this year. He also leaves behind in New Hampshire his aunt, Marjorie Hultgren Stokes, and his cousins Shaughn, Lyn, Peter and Bill Bolton, with whom he spent much of his youth.
