On the afternoon of July 10, 2021, Leonard M. Miller, 94, died peacefully at his home in Bloomfield, Ct.

Born in Milford, MA to George & Dora Miller, he was the eldest of his brothers Richard, Norman, Marvin and Melvin. Leonard served his country from 1943–1945 as a Merchant Marine and from 1949-1951 as a Marine. His command of the waters was enviable. Upon an Honorable Discharge, he then worked with his father and brothers in the dry cleaning business before serving the Hartford Police Department as a police officer with brother Norm, in the mid '60's. He then owned and ran an asphalt company and later, a chain of dry-cleaning establishments in Hartford. Len was passionate about life; he loved boating, fishing, baseball (he threw a mean sinker!), football, and was enthusiastic about playing dominoes with friends and family. A loving man, he enjoyed and partook in practical jokes, had great wit and was very strong willed. Leonard believed intensely in honesty, integrity and his country.

He is pre-deceased by his parents, George and Dora, his first wife, Margarita, her sisters and brother, and his brothers Melvin, Norman and Richie. He is survived by his loving wife Nancy (Klein/Sweet) of 23 years, his brother Marvin (Phyllis), children Ron (Elizabeth) Christine and Margo (Michael), grandchildren Lauren and Jaimie and many cousins, nephews, nieces. He also leaves behind her sister Lisa, brothers Gary and Dick (Laura) her sons Stacey (Donna) and Scott (Christine), their children and many grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces, nephews and cousins and close friends Harry

and Marianne, “Mr. Chris” and Frank.
