Lesley Jennifer (Jenny) Hunt (83) died peacefully Saturday, July 14, 2018 after a heroic fight with Leukemia. Jenny was born in the U.K. on May 3rd, 1935. She is survived by her brother John, her son Michael, her daughter Dawn, her grandchildren Gareth, David, Ryan, Jessica and Shaun, and her great-granddaughter Emmeline. Jenny was raised in London by her parents Leslie and Ethel (Essie) Mary and lived her extraordinarily productive life there until making her way across the Atlantic upon her retirement at the age of 78. Jenny is remembered by her many students of the Jenny Hunt Pre-school Nursery and the Jenny Hunt Dancing School in New Malden, Surrey, where she often taught more than one generation of the same family. From pre-school students in the morning to their parents in the evening, Jenny was always the liveliest of teachers. Her friends and family will recall Jenny as always being the most active member of the family and willing to do anything for anyone, regardless of the time or place. During her well-earned but all too brief retirement years, Jenny was happy to make new friends in the U.S. and particularly enjoyed introducing them to her favorite English colloquialisms. Jenny is remembered as a devoted mother, grand-mother, great-grandmother and friend, for whom nothing was ever too much trouble. She loved to talk to anyone and everyone, and nothing gave her greater pleasure than to discover the willingness of people to spend time discussing life, the universe and everything with her. Jenny's family are particularly grateful to the doctors and nurses of UConn Health, that worked so tirelessly on her behalf this past year.

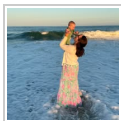
