



## Lewis V. McCormick

April 10, 1916 - December 28, 2010

Col. Lewis V. McCormick died on December 28, 2010 after a brief illness at the age of 94. Born on April 10, 1916 in Bloomfield to John and Helen Francis McCormick, he was the youngest of eight children. He was a proud U.S. Army veteran and he served with the Connecticut Army Guard Selective Service 43rd Infantry Division. He remained with the division through service that started at Guadalcanal and ended in Tokyo, Japan in 1945 following VJ Day. He retired from the Army Reserve in 1976. After the war, he returned to work at Connecticut Light and Power and continued his employment until his retirement from Northeast Utilities in 1981. He was predeceased by his beloved wife of 42 years, Catherine McGurkin, and his siblings, Howard, Robert, John Clayton, Edwin, Helen Sullivan, and Gertrude Reeve. He is survived by his children, Mary Lewis McCormick and husband Timothy Hawks, Philip and Katherine Stosonis McCormick, John and Kay Tumer McCormick, and David and Eileen Fitzgerald McCormick.
